
# POLICY

**SECTION:** Miscellaneous  
**SUBJECT:** Election of Special Areas (Road) Committee

07-01

In order to facilitate the election of Special Areas Board Committee Members at the Annual Taxpayer Meetings, (in the same year as local Municipal Elections - every 3 years), the following policy and procedures will be followed:

- 1) the Road Committee Member must reside in the Area in which he is a representative,
- 2) the Chairman of the meeting will call for nominations from each Area,
- 3) nominations will be accepted from Taxpayers at the meeting whether or not they reside in the member's Area,
- 4) if a single nomination is received for an Area, the Chairman will declare that person elected after three calls for nominations,
- 5) if more than one nomination is received for an Area, the vote will be by secret ballot,
- 6) if, during their term of office, an elected member resigns or relocates outside his Area, nominations will be called at the next Annual Taxpayer Meeting in that subdivision to elect an interim member.
