**SUBJECT:** Access for Seismic Drill Lines and Well Site Development  
Near Water Bodies within the Special Areas

The Special Areas Board prohibits seismic drilling within historical water lines of all water bodies with the Special Areas.

The Special Areas Board prohibits wellsite establishment (MSL boundary) within 100 meters of the historical water lines of named water bodies within the Special Areas and within 150 meters of top of bank of the Red Deer and South Saskatchewan Rivers.

The Special Areas Board prohibits placement of the well center within 100 meters of:

- i. The historical water lines of non-named wetlands as identified in the Alberta Wetland Classification System (2015) with the exception of temporary marshes (Class 2 – Stewart and Kantrud classification system).
- ii. Topographic features such as coulee breaks and other unique landscape formations as identified by the Special Areas Board from time to time.
