**SUBJECT:** 

Parking of Water Trucks on Special Areas Roads

Every public highway, road, street, and lane in the Special Areas is subject to the direction, control, and management of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, except for highways designated as a primary highway under the Public Highways Development Act. The practice of parking water trucks on public roads to load with water has proven dangerous by obstructing traffic, as well as causing damage to road surfaces and shoulders.

The parking of water trucks on public highways, roads, streets, and lanes in the Special Areas shall be prohibited for the purpose of loading water from canals, ditches, or other sources of supply.
