Application Criteria

There are many century farms and ranches in the Special Areas. Criteria have been set to identify these families. It includes the following:

- at the time of application your land has been continuously owned by your family and actively farmed or ranched for a minimum of 100 years*
- you can provide evidence clearly demonstrating the kinship ties between you and the founder of the farm, ranch or homestead (family tree)
- you can provide the legal land location
- you can provide a copy of the homestead search** or Dominion of Land certificate
- you can provide the current ownership land title (available from Special Areas District Office for a fee)
- the current size of the original homestead or land base must be at least 160 acres of land

Please note

* The 100 years starts from the time the land was occupied for farming or ranching as noted on the Homestead Application or Dominion of Land certificate.

** You can search the homestead document(s) at the Provincial Archives of Alberta yourself, or you can phone the Archives to do the search for you, for a charge. The address of the Archives is: Provincial Archives of Alberta, Reference Desk, 8555 Roper Road, Edmonton, Alberta, T6E 5W1.
