Roads


2024 Major Projects & Secondary Highways

- Operational Season in 2024
 - Road Construction 13.0 km (including Sheerness Industrial Park & Reservoir project)
 - Road Re-Crowning 35+ km
 - Road Surfacing 28.8 km (GBC/DSC) & 29 km (Paving Hwy 855)
 - RAP (Recycled Asphalt Pavement) Hamlet Streets
- Secondary Highways
 - Partnership with Alberta Transportation three-digit highways
 - Discussions ongoing for next agreement
 - GBC Program 2 years remaining
 - Working to create 10-year paving plan based on surface condition & strength data
 - Paving Project Hwy 855 (deferred from 2023)
 - 50/50 cost share with Alberta Transportation

Emergency Services

Regional Fire Services & Emergency Management

- SAB Regional Fire Services:
 - Regional training continues NFPA 1001 Level 1 & 2 (fall 2024)
 - New Fire Hall in Cessford
 - RFP and Construction (2024)
 - Shared building with SAB Roads
 - New Tender (Water Tanker) in Cessford
 - Delivery 2025
- Regional Emergency Management:
 - Re-engaging with municipalities in SA region on the Regional Emergency Management Plan (REMP)
 - Fall 2024: REMP table-top exercise
 - 2025: REMP functional exercise



Emergency Services

Enforcement Services

- Community Peace Officers
 - Increased presence on surfaced roads, construction sites, large industrial developments and enforcement support in municipal parks & campgrounds.
 - Goal to have 3 Community Peace Officers with extended coverage
 - Recruitment efforts continue (2 full-time CPO positions)
- Special Areas Road Use Order approved
 - Helps protect investment in SAB local roads & public safety
 - Summer 2024 Agricultural Producers exempt
 - Producers are asked to contact their local Road Foreman if they will be having 10+ loads in a 24-hour period
 - Winter 2024 Voluntary online notification system for 10+ loads



Parks & Campgrounds

2024 Season

- Development Focus for SAB municipal parks & campgrounds
- Prairie Oasis Park:
 - Engineering for expansion of shower facilities
 - Concession upgrades
- Blood Indian Park
 - Investigation/pre-engineering for alternate location for store
 - Fisheries & Management Objective (FMO) discussions
- Carolside Campground:
 - Power to campground (serviced sites in 2025)
- 10-year operational agreement with Province
 - Little Fish Lake & Gooseberry Lake Provincial Parks
